## Re: Canadian Resident Match – Forensic Psychiatry resident positions for Academic year starting July 1<sup>st</sup> 2024

The Forensic Psychiatry Residency Programs across the country will hold a Match. The process and timelines for the match for Forensic Psychiatry Residency positions for the academic year starting July  $1^{\rm st}$  2024 is as follows:

<u>Please apply to the programs that you wish to attend and complete their interview and selection processes.</u>

It is expected that the match results will be respected by both applicants and programs. Please do not rank a program if you have no intention to train there. The match process is a collegial approach that impacts all candidates and programs, and the second iteration will not include candidates that were matched during the first iteration.

- 1. <u>September 1, 2023</u>: Application Deadline for all Forensic Psychiatry Subspecialty Programs.
- 2. October 20, 2023: Notify programs if you are withdrawing from the Canadian Match.
- 3. October 24, 2023 at 6pm EST: deadline for each applicant to e-mail their ranking for each program where they interviewed and would accept a position. Candidates are to email their rankings to Dr. Joel Watts, <a href="mailto:jc.watts.mpc@gmail.com">jc.watts.mpc@gmail.com</a>, who will confirm via email that the ranking was received.
- 4. Please title the e-mail "Forensic Psychiatry Match 2023 Rankings". Your email should include the following:
  - Your name
  - Your current residency program
  - Your rank list from top to bottom:

- 5. October 24, 2023 at 6pm EST: deadline for each Program Director to email Dr. Joel Watts at jc.watts.mpc@gmail.com.
  - The number of funded positions for FRCPC Canadian candidates.
  - List of applicant(s) with their rankings. Also contact information for each candidate.

Positions will be matched based on the matching algorithm.

- 6. <u>October 27, 2023</u>: Letter of offer to be sent to candidates by each Program. You will only be contacted by the program to which you have been successfully matched.
- 7. October 30, 2023 at 12 noon EST: Deadline for candidates to return a signed copy of letter of offer.
- 8. Candidates who are unmatched, will receive a notification email from Dr. Watts outlining remaining unmatched positions across the country. Candidates will have the opportunity to contact these programs directly if they choose to do so.
