TTP General Psychiatry

- **July – October – during TTD and FOD geriatric psychiatry**
 - **Complete EPAs:**
 - Managing the clinical and administrative aspects of a psychiatric practice
 - Supervising junior trainees
 - **In addition to RTE “Any Psychiatric Practice”, add in RTE:**
 - After-hours coverage for psychiatry or one of its subspecialties
 - (really adding this back in, at a lower frequency)
- **Nov- Dec – during FOD Ger Med and Cog Neuro**
 - Formal instruction of required topics, using e-links/resources, with protected time, and need to sign off.

Core of Discipline (COD)

*electives (academic or community) – June and October and Feb are optional electives, else can expand main rotation to 4 months. **Note that at least 3 months of all electives must be in Geriatric Psychiatry, including the last 2 months of training (TTP).**

Note that the 3 main COD mandatory rotations (Outpatient, Outreach, Inpatient) can be done in any order. Recommend 4 months each, but can do minimum 3 months for any or all, adding electives as above.
